

Declaration regarding the REACH Regulation

1907/2006/EC

List of Substances of Very High Concern - SVHC

SVHCs (Substances of Very High Concern) are chemical compounds (or part of a group of chemical compounds) whose authorisation for use in the EU is covered by the REACH Regulation. The classification of a substance as a SVHC by the European Chemicals Agency (ECHA) is the first step in the procedure for authorising and restricting chemicals. The first list of SVHCs was published on 28 October 2008.

It was last updated on January 24, 2024. This list includes 240 substances.

We declare that the circuit boards and other products put on the market by ANDUS contain less than 0.1% of the substances identified in the list mentioned before.

In addition, ANDUS obeys the restrictions of Annex XVII to REACH.
